Rules of engagement

in the event of inclement weather then the first round requirement for hoops may be reduced by one hoop

The first round has been seeded to put player of equal golf level as far as possible together.

It may be considered necessary to prevent any player achieving the winning hoop by co-operating with other players to achieve this end.

The second round shall consist of the four winners followed by the four second best etc. as far as possible. Decisions about grouping may be effected by Golf handicaps as well. EG two players get 2 hoops in a losing game, then Golf handicaps will apply for the next grouping. Thus a player rated 8 say will play in a higher grouping than one rated 10, neither being winners.

Three rounds to be completed before lunch..
Two rounds after lunch.

The winner shall be the winner of most games.
If there is more than one winner then the number of hoops achieved shall be included.
If this does not determine the winner then a final knock out round of potential winners shall be conducted
